RULES FOR RESPONSIBLE INTERNET USE IN SCHOOL

PLEASE SHARE THESE RULES WITH YOUR CHILD

- My internet use will always be supervised by an adult.
- I will always ask permission from a member of staff before using the internet and will always search the Internet through the “Safe Search” on The Grid home page.
- I will only open, use and delete my own files.
- I will use ICT in school for school purposes only.
- I will only use my class email address when emailing at school.
- I will not bring in and use removable storage devices, such as floppy disks or memory sticks, unless I have school permission.
- I will not give out my home address or phone number, or arrange to meet someone unless my parent, carer or teacher has given permission.
- I will not deliberately look for, save or send anything that could be unpleasant or nasty. If I accidentally find anything like this, I will tell my teacher or another adult immediately.
- I understand that the school can check on my computer files at any time and monitor the Internet sites I use.
- I will make sure that all my ICT contact with other people is responsible, polite and sensible.
- I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- I understand that if I break these internet rules, I will lose my internet privileges.
