On this day in history.

- In 1547 King Henry VIII died. He was succeeded by his 9 year-old son, Edward VI.
- In 1807 Pall Mall in London became the first street lit by gaslight. An example of one of these gas lights is in the photo opposite.
- In 1986 – The U.S. space shuttle *Challenger* exploded just after take-off. All seven of its crewmembers were killed. One of the astronauts was a teacher who was due to deliver lessons from space and as a result many children were watching the launch and saw the disaster.

Remember you only need to complete a section of the workbook each day.



Don’t forget to use look, say, cover, write, check to help you learn them. Make sure you practise them daily.


Topic

Art



You need to look at the instruction sheet that is in the home learning folder on the school’s


