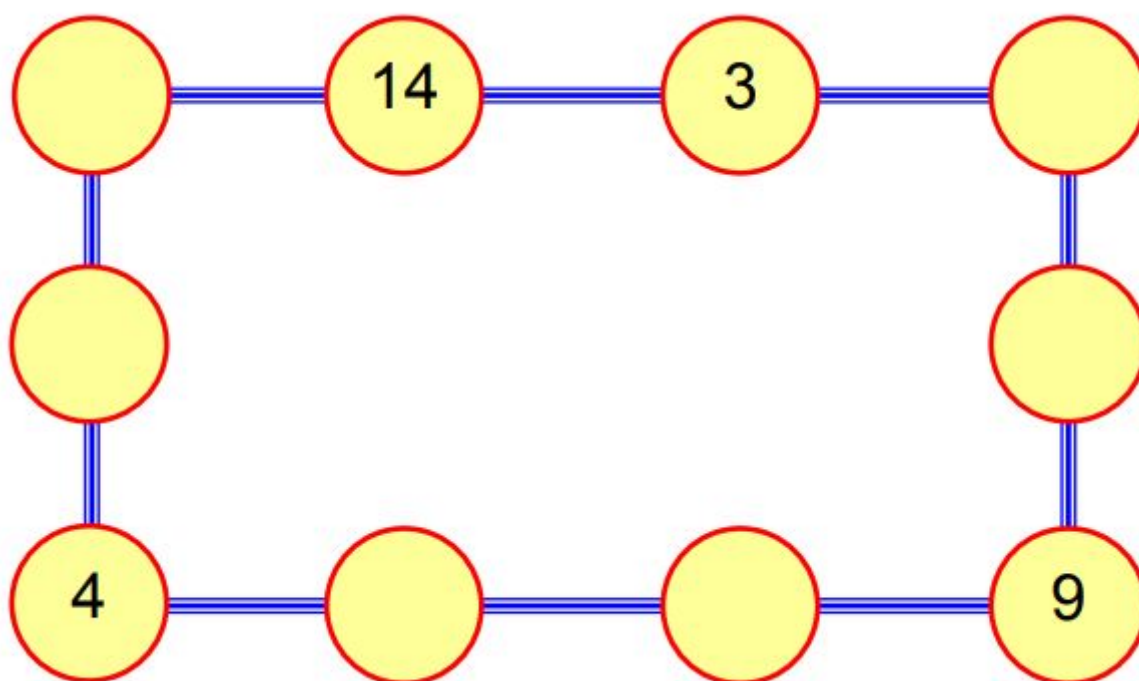


Good Morning Year 4! It is the fourth day of the week! We are so close to the weekend! Keep up all your lovely work! We have been amazed by your perseverance and determination!

Reread 'Voices in the Park' by Anthony Browne using the link below.

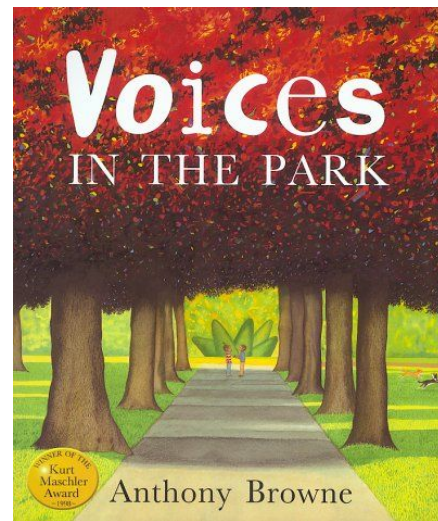

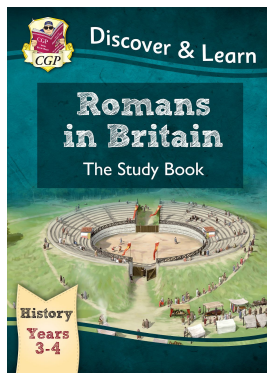
Time connectives
