On this day in history.

- In 1923 one of the world's most famous steam locomotives entered service with the LNER – The Flying Scotsman. (See photo on the right.) It has been preserved and still pulls trains to this day.
- In 1942 The Battle of Los Angeles took place. During World War Two, anti-aircraft guns fired at a mysterious target over the city that was thought to be a Japanese air raid. No aircraft were actually there – it was a false alarm. There is a possibility it was a weather balloon that was seen, while some people today believe that they were firing at a UFO! Tragically, it led to the deaths of 5 people on the ground.
- In 1998 Elton John was knighted by the Queen at Buckingham Palace.

Click on the link, select today's date and then select your difficulty. Bronze is the easiest. You can then check your answers.



Go Read – Remember you **MUST** be recording your reading daily.


### Topic


