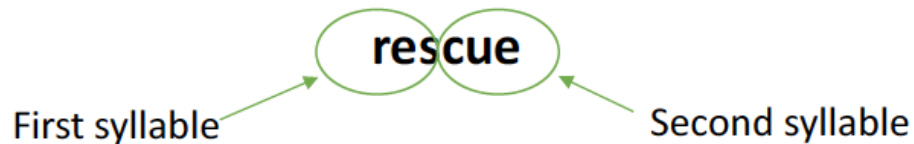


The Catch

Haiku Poem (5-7-5)

A syllable is a sound which makes up a word:



Haiku poems are made using three lines.

Haiku syllable rule:

First line: 5 syllables

Second line: 7 syllables

Third line: 5 syllables

Example:

A boy- hungry, small 5 syllables

A rescued fox showing thanks 7 syllables

Desperate tribe, saved. 5 syllables
