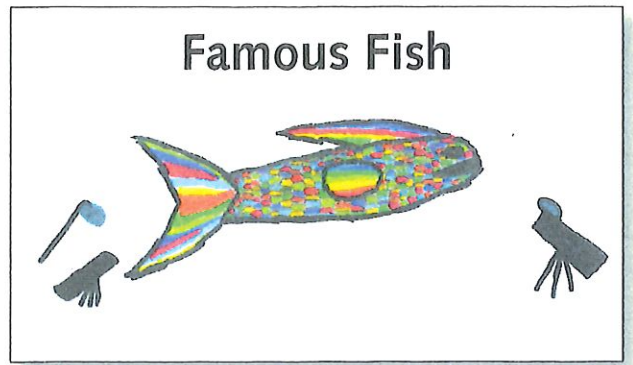

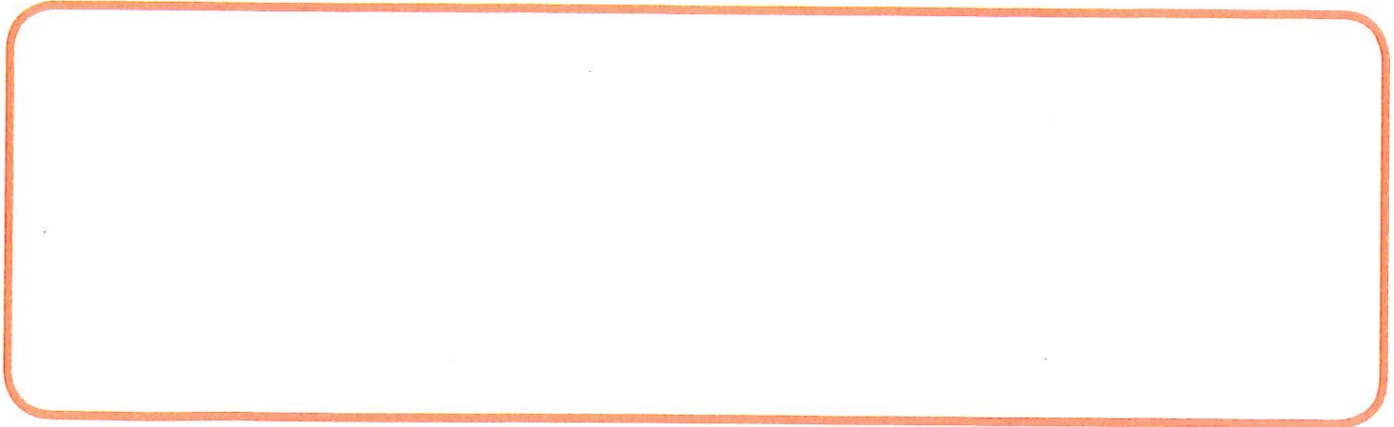

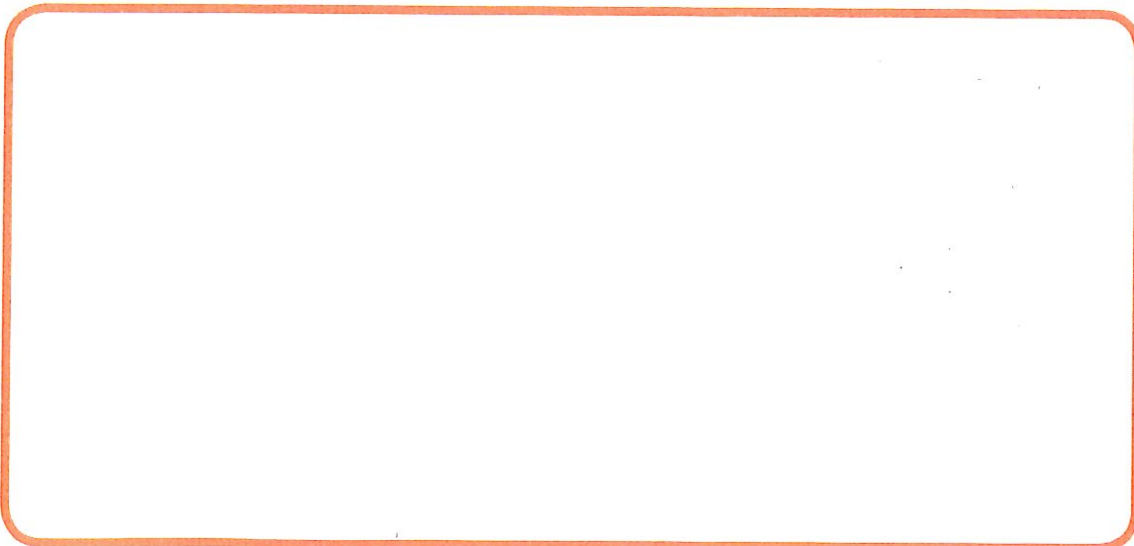


"I am marvellous!" said the fish pompously. "I am not dangerous and it is obvious I will be famous very soon. I find it rather humorous that you are all so envious."
