If you are getting all the questions correct, you can either change your level, or set yourself a time limit for the questions.


Mark yesterday's White Rose worksheet. The answers will be on the home learning page.

**Journey to the River Sea: Today's task is based on Chapter 11.**


**Design a party invitation** for Olga's birthday party.

## Topic

### Independent project

We are giving you 2 topic afternoons so you can work on your very own project. We want you to be really creative and independent, but also resourceful. Try to use what you already have at home. We can't wait to see what you come up with!



Start with your theme:

- Is it going to be something you already know lots about like a sport perhaps, or crafts, or space?
- Will it be a theme you are really interested in, but need to do further research – the environment, or cooking or photography, or animals?
- Perhaps you want to set yourself a design challenge – what about designing a new theme park? Or a new lockdown game? Or a new supercar?




Next, you need to start gathering ideas and doing your research:

- Do you need to use the internet and make notes?
- Do you need to try making the model?
- Do you need to test out some recipes?
- Do you need to practise the sport?

Finally, think about how you are going to present your project and share it with others:

- Will you need drawings?
- Will you make a model?
- Will you cook?
- Will you need a book?
- Will you use the computer?
- Will you need to take photographs?



Use today's session to get organised and make a plan. What do you need to do and when does it need to be done by? You may need to do a little bit each day, so you don't feel overwhelmed on finishing off day next Friday.
